



## *Dearborn Heights Recycling Center*



The Recycling Center is located next to the John F. Kennedy Library 24602 Van Born Road, about ¼ mile west of Telegraph Rd. It is open year round 7:00am – 5:00pm Monday thru Friday. Separate drop-off bins for glass, metals, newspapers, and plastics are neatly arranged at the center.

### *Preparing Recyclables:*

**Newspapers:** can be bagged or bundled, no plastic bags. Cardboard, magazines, office paper, and phone books may also be recycled with newspapers.

**Glass:** bottles and jars only. Remove caps and lids, clean and rinse, labels okay. Sort by color – clear or brown. NO flat glass (windows, shower doors, etc.), ceramic or green glass.

**Metal** (magnetic): Cans, jar lids, etc. Clean, remove bottom & labels & flatten.

**Aluminum** (non-magnetic): Includes clean pie plates, crumpled foil, cans, doors, siding, lawn chairs, etc.

**Plastics:** Milk jugs and bottles labeled PETE (1) or HDPE (2). Discard caps, rinse and flatten. No bags or cartons even if they have code symbols.
